

'Mr. Monster is HUNGRY! There are lots of way to make Mr. Monster HAPPY and FULL!'

First, practice your **scissor** (fine motor) skills by cutting out each letter. It's okay to practice with a grownup! Child's hand over a grown-up's hand works best.

Have your grownup cut an opening in Mr. Monster's mouth.

Once the letters are cut out then let the learning fun begin!

Choose 1 or more options to work on letter and sound recognition:

- 1. Hide the letters around your home for a scavenger hunt! Feed Mr. Monster as you find and name each letter- YUM!
- 2. Have your child match the Uppercase to the Lowercase letter and then feed the matching pair to the hungry monster!
- 3. Let your child say the sound of the letter before feeding it to the monster
- 4. Practice tracing or writing each letter before you feed Mr. Monster
- 5. Mix up all the letters! Arrange the capital letters in ABC order singing the Alphabet song
- 6. Mix up all the letters! Arrange the lowercase letters in ABC order singing the Alphabet song

How many 2 or 3 letter words can you write looking at all the Monster letters? Feed Mr. Monster all the letters when you are finished writing.
