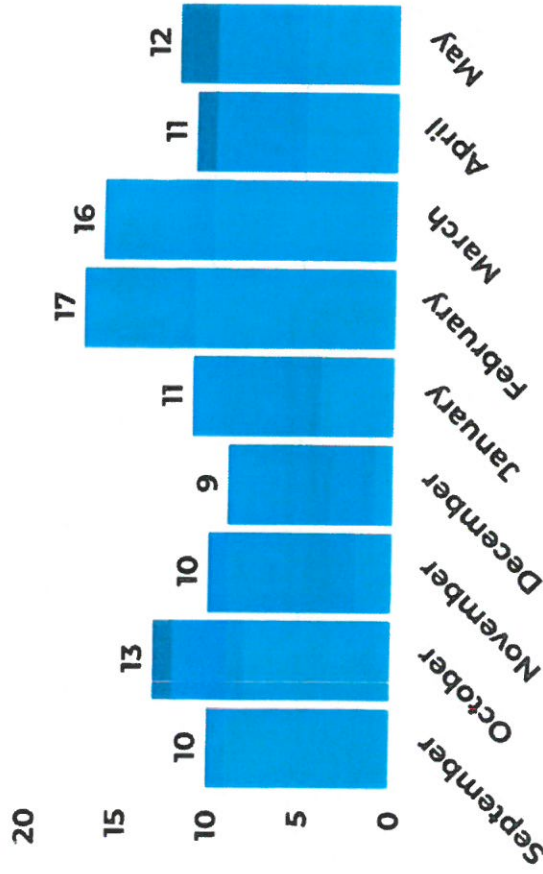

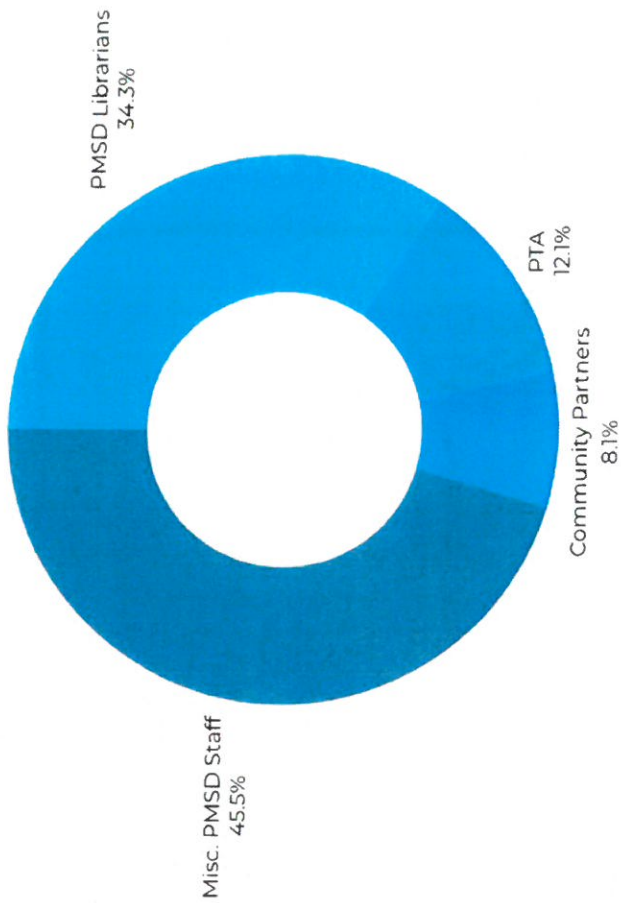

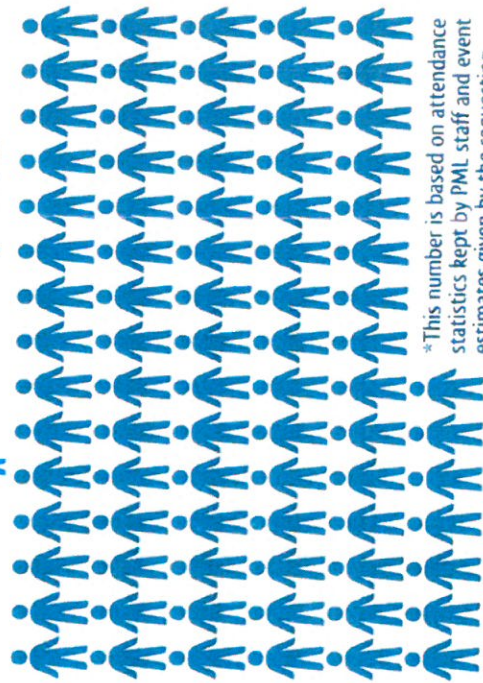
Where Do Youth Services' Outreach Invitations Come From?

There is a dedicated YS outreach team of five staff members who coordinate staffing, develop activities, and provide promotional materials and setup supplies for year-round events.
